

Homeschool Art Show 2014

Olathe Public Library - Main Library
201 E. Park Street, in downtown Olathe

Olathe Public Library will host a **Homeschool Art Show** from November 1 - 30, 2014. All Olathe-area homeschooled youth aged 6-18 (grades 1-12) are invited to submit a piece of original art for this show. A public "Meet the Artists" reception will be held on Tuesday, November 11, 2014 (see below); all Art Show participants are invited to attend, along with guests.

To submit your artwork, please read these guidelines carefully and complete an Artist Information Form to be turned in when you submit your artwork.

Artwork guidelines:

- Art should be two-dimensional (flat), and should be no larger than 18" x 24".
- Art should be mounted on construction paper, stiff board, or similar material to give it extra support. Leave a border so that we can staple through the border to hang the art on the wall without damaging your art.
- Any media is acceptable, as long as the artwork is two-dimensional. (Possible media include—but are not limited to—acrylic or tempera paint, oil pastels, cut paper, collage, or mixed media.)
- Each artist may submit only one piece of art for the show.
- Please do not include images of licensed characters (for example, Mickey Mouse, Pokémon, etc.) in your art.
- Art must have been completed within the last year.
- Please complete an **Artist Information Form** and submit it with your artwork. (Please complete, detach, and affix the **Art Identification Form** section to the back of your artwork.) This form is available at both Olathe Public Library locations, and also available for download from the OPL website, www.olathelibrary.org.
- Olathe Public Library reserves the right not to include any piece of artwork submitted for this art show.

Important Dates:

October 18 – October 26: Drop off artwork at Main Library

Artwork may be dropped off at the Main Library (201 E. Park St) ONLY, at the Children's Desk during library hours. Be sure to submit a completed **Artist Information Form** and attach a completed **Art Identification Form** to the back of your artwork.

November 1 – November 30: Artwork on display

Artwork will be on display at the Main Library, 201 E. Park Street.

November 11, 7:00 – 8:00 p.m.: "Meet the Artists" reception

Join your fellow artists, friends, family, and the public for a reception to celebrate the show! Light refreshments will be served.

December 6 – 14: Pick up artwork from Main Library

Artwork may be picked up at the Main Library (201 E. Park St) ONLY, at the Children's Desk during library hours.
